

Exciting Partnership in Côte de'Ivoire

In an innovative project, South Meridian Church of God in Anderson, Indiana, is tithing its current capital funds campaign to sponsor eight children for 12 years in Côte d'Ivoire, West Africa. A care group from the church will communicate with, care for, and integrate these children into the life of the church on a regular basis.

The first installment of funds (\$13,500) was presented on COP Sunday at South Meridian on September 20. Bobby and Jenny Mishill, missionaries for Global Strategy, are doing the preparation and leadership training for this program, which will eventually be led by nationals. It will be launched in July 2016. Bobby and Jenny interacted over Facetime with the congregation on September 20.
