Children of Promise has always been about quality care. We want to make sure that the sponsored children are receiving the most they can from the donations you give. We have over 1,000 volunteers who work hard to stretch every dollar. However, rising food, education, and health care costs over the last ten years have resulted in it becoming more and more difficult to provide the same care for the same sponsorship prices of \$25, \$30, and \$40 per month.

Therefore, the Children of Promise Board of Directors announces changes in the monthly sponsorship amounts. As of August 1, 2015, the new monthly amounts for the children's care will be as follows:

- Present \$25 (since 2005) sponsorships will move to \$32.
- Present \$30 (since 1993) sponsorships will move to \$38.
- Present \$40 (since 2010) sponsorships will move to \$50.

We have been blessed to be able to keep most of the sponsorship fees the same for the past ten years. Even with the new monthly sponsorship amounts, we will still be below the amounts charged by similar organizations.

The Board of Directors has prayerfully reviewed detailed information from the directors of our programs regarding the costs of benefits for nutrition, education, and health care. They have also studied the sponsorship rates of other similar programs. (See the reverse side for more detailed information.)

Currently, out of \$25 a child receives benefits of \$21.25. From the proceeds of a child sponsored for \$32 per month, the child now will receive benefits of \$25.60. This includes an administrative cost of 20%, as also directed by the Board of Directors due to rising costs in operations. This is the first change from 15% since 1992. We will still be raising the monthly amounts significantly for the children.

Children of Promise has the most wonderful sponsors. When a rate change was necessary for most sponsorships ten years ago, our sponsors responded enthusiastically. Thank you for loving and caring for the children you sponsor. If the new rates present a hardship to you, why not ask a friend to join you in the sponsorship or ask us how you might be able to support Children of Promise in other ways?

We hope and pray that all our sponsors will be at the new rates by February 1, 2016. Please join us in continuing to provide for the children well.


